ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENT LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Shinpei Kuo filed an application for administrative approval to a Mixed-Use Planned Development on a project known as Ted's Montana Grill for a deviation from LDC Sec. 30-5(13) to allow specific figure-structured signs on property located at 8017 Plaza Del Lago, described more particularly as:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: In Section 04, Township 47 South, Range 25 East, Lee County, Florida:

WHEREAS, the property was originally rezoned in case number DRI2000-00015 & DCI2001-00005 (with subsequent amendments in case numbers DRI2004-00008, ADD2004-00048, ADD2004-00060, ADD2004-00060(A), ADD2004-00060(B), ADD2004-00060(C), ADD2004-00187, ADD2004-00187(A), ADD2004-00206, ADD2005-00011, ADD2005-00026, ADD2005-00080, ADD2005-00080(A), and ADD2006-00024); and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the Urban Community Future Land Use Category as designated by the Lee Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Land Development Code provides for certain administrative changes to planned development master concept plans and planned unit development final development plans; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the subject property, Coconut Point Developers, LLC, have given authorization to Shinpei Kuo to pursue this application; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is requesting a deviation from the schedule of uses for the Coconut Point MPD which allows *Signs, in accordance with LDC chapter 30*, to allow a specific figure-structured sign which appears on the corporate logo; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted a copy of the proposed sign package for Ted's Montana Grill to the master developer (Coconut Point Developers, LLC), the Estero Design Review Committee, and to Lee County Community Development staff; and

WHEREAS, the proposed sign package has received approval of the Coconut Point Developers, LLC, and the Estero Design Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, Gordon Lyons, Chairman of the Estero Design Review Committee, put the package to a vote at the EDRC meeting on August 9, 2006, and the committee considered the signage package as a making a positive impact to the Coconut Point development; and

WHEREAS, the concerns from the EDRC included the potential for exposed neon tubing, as well as the scale of a "96-inch Externally Lit Aluminum Wall Sign" being too large for that side of the building; and

WHEREAS, the signs are proposed to be externally lit, so there will be no exposed neon tubing; and

WHEREAS, the EDRC members felt that a "96-inch Externally Lit Aluminum Wall Sign" should be similar in scale to the two windows on either side of the sign; and

WHEREAS, the applicant submitted to the County on August 23, 2006, a set of plans including a "84-inch Externally Lit Aluminum Wall Sign" which appears to be similar in scale to the two windows on either side of the signage; and

WHEREAS, the blade signs, as proposed are appropriate for the Coconut Point development, as they are very European in nature, and fit well with the Mediterranean character of the development and greater community; and

WHEREAS, the subject application and plans have been reviewed by the Lee County Department of Community Development in accordance with applicable regulations for compliance with all terms of the administrative approval procedures; and

WHEREAS, it is found that the proposed amendment does not increase density or intensity within the development; does not decrease buffers or open space required by the LDC; does not underutilize public resources or infrastructure; does not reduce total open space, buffering, landscaping or preservation areas; and does not otherwise adversely impact on surrounding land uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED that the application for administrative approval for an amendment for a deviation from LDC Sec. 30-5(13) to allow specific figure-structured signs for a Mixed-Use Planned Development is **APPROVED**, **subject to the following conditions:**

- 1. The Development must be in substantial compliance with the proposed sign package, stamped received by Zoning on August 23, 2006. A copy of this 9-page package is attached hereto as "Exhibit B."
- 2. Neon tubing shall be prohibited on all of the proposed signs.
- 3. No internal lighting is allowed in any of these proposed signs. They must be externally lit by way of "gooseneck" light fixtures, directed towards the signage from a position above the signs themselves.
- 4. The size of any one sign may be no greater than 8% of any exterior wall surface, in order to scale the sign more appropriately for the building's features.

5. The terms and conditions of the original zoning resolutions remain in full force and effect, except as amended herein.
