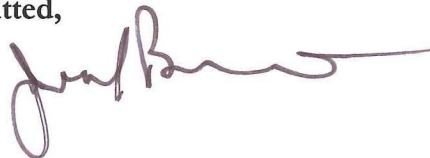
As I previously mentioned in my email and telephone call to you, Grandedzza residents are extremely upset that the recent submittal by Miromar re the University Village Phase 1 submittal has asked for another deviation which we know will affect us. This deviation absolutely needs a public hearing! We have spent over a \$100,000 to get a UV plan that still works more in Miromar's benefits than for Grandedzza.

Our residents need to voice their concerns re this issue and we feel this should not be decided in an Administrative Hearing without public input! Miromar had plenty of opportunities to put this forward at the exhaustive public meetings when both sides had a chance to comment. A simple review of the supposedly final approvals would show 2 dozen deviations already!

The residents of Grandedzza are stunned that Miromar would try to slide in another deviation and this is only Phase 1! Please give this issue your most serious consideration.
